Financial Commitment Card

In an effort to erase our financial shortfall for 2017 and meet our financial commitments, the leadership is asking the families at Oakwood to pray about how we can each be a part of getting Oakwood on good financial footing as we begin a new season of life with a new Lead Pastor.

Below is a Financial Commitment card that was available at the Congregational Meeting on July 23, and will be available in your Worship Program for the next few weeks.

Please pray about what God would have your family do, fill out the card, and return it to the church either by putting it in the offering basket, dropping it in the wood box by the exit doors, or mail it or drop it by the Church Office by August 13.

As has been done in the past when the church family has been asked to consider sacrificial giving, the leadership (elders and deacons) have led the way by presenting their commitments first. Last Sunday their commitments were \$7,800 in one time giving and \$1,100 in additional monthly giving.

FINANCIAL COMMITMENT TO OCC

Understanding the following:

- That there is a \$21,000 deficit in the general fund in the first six months of 2017 (approximately \$3,500 per month)...
- That the budget needs to increase by \$1,100 per month to meet the needs of our next Servant Leader...
- That 50 people giving approximately \$90 per month above regular tithes and offerings will meet the financial shortfall...
- That 21 people giving \$1,000 by October 1st would erase the shortfall from the first 6 months...

I prayerfully commit the following:

- To evaluate my financial commitments to this world which will pass away, and increase my financial commitments to that which will not pass away...
 - To begin and/or continue regular tithes and/or offerings.
- ____ To trust the Lord for \$_____ per month above my regular tithes and offerings for the next twelve months to stop the monthly financial shortfall.
- ____ To give a one-time offering of \$_____ by October 1st to help erase the deficit of the first six months.


