Labor Day


The Church Office will be closed on Monday, September 5 for Labor Day.

Grasping God's Word—Women's Adult Education Class

This class is intended for women who are serious about getting a firm grip on the solid rock of Scripture – how to read it, how to interpret it, and how to apply it. Our approach will be hands-on using numerous biblical examples to help guide us through the 3-fold interpretive journey. This fall session will focus on some basic tools for careful reading and how to determine the context. 
