Congregational Meeting recap

The Elders called a Congregational Meeting on September 18 to give an update on where Oakwood is financially.

Dave DePagter gave a financial report. Our YTD Offerings have been \$76,935 less than Expenses. The months of July and August have been better because we have finished the severance package with Paul Phair, but we are still not meeting our expenses. The anticipated monthly shortfall, if there are no changes, is \$3,500 per month.

Larry Chute, representing the elders, gave a report from the elders on their decisions to remedy this and how the Oakwood family can help.

The elders considered three options:

- 1. Increase Income
- 2. Reduce Expenses
- 3. A combination of the above

They looked at the possibility of reducing staff, but feel that would weaken the home base. Ministry leaders have willingly tightened their belts and will continue to do so. The office is functioning frugally. The Deacons are to be commended for skillfully stewarding the budget.

They have chosen Option 3.

- 1. We are asking the Church family to voluntarily increase income by \$2,500 per month. If 50 people will increase their giving by \$12.50 per week, that goal is met.
- 2. We are reducing the missions support from 18% of undesignated offerings to 15%, thereby reducing expenses another \$1,000 per month. This is not without precedent—we have taken this step previously in lean seasons.

We do have some rental income, but believe that the church should primarily be supported by tithes and offerings, not rental income that could end at any time. Currently, 80% of the rental income is going to undesignated income and 20% is going into a Facility Equity Fund to help with larger facility expenses (AC replacements, repairs, etc.). The 80% of rental income will help us replenish the \$77,000 deficit for the year.

Larry reminded us that in Isaiah 54:2 the Lord instructed his people to "Lengthen the cords...Strengthen the stakes."

Will you pray about your part in helping Oakwood strengthen our base?

Food Bag Ministry


