Good Friday – Joint Worship Service!

It was a blessing to partner with Bahia Vida on March 17, as we split into teams and visited hundreds of homes in Plantation and right next to church to invite people to church. What we told people that day was, "We are two churches but we have one campus, one message and one mission!"

On Good Friday we will illustrate that unity by coming together to sing the praises of Jesus in both English and Spanish, to read God's Word and hear a message from Pastor Darin and Pastor Josue and then to gather around the Lord's table together. Since this is our first joint worship service, we decided to make it a celebration of both Jesus' death *and* resurrection, so the tone of the evening will be more upbeat than some other Good Friday services you may have attended in the past.

Come to remember Jesus' death. Come to rejoice in his resurrection. Come to connect with our brothers and sisters in Christ at Bahia Vida. And please invite your friends, neighbors and loved ones to join us for both Good Friday and Easter Sunday! This is the time of year people are most likely to attend a church service – don't miss the opportunity!

Our Two Services Experiment

You may have wondered, "Who moved my seat?" We are trying out some different seating configurations to maximize our worship center space for the attendance numbers we expect at each service. There are two principles we are balancing: 1) the chairs should be at least 50% full so the service doesn't feel empty and 2) the chairs should be 20-25% empty so newcomers can tell there is room for them. This is why we are moving extra chairs into place after the 9:00 service and in preparation for the 10:30 service. Please help the ushers if you are able! And please help us welcome and host the guests who come!

Pastor Darin will begin a new message series


The Gospel

Update on our Search Process



We are moving this direction not out of need but as a strategic effort to build on our strengths and position us to keep growing and even accelerate the growth God is



giving us by investing in these top priority ministries! This hire represents a step of faith for us as we will be asking for a 13-14% budget increase to fund this position and make some other financial adjustments in our fiscal year starting July 1.
