The Power of God for Salvation

We are halfway through our sermon series on *The Gospel*, studying the 10 saving acts of Jesus. In Romans 1, Paul wrote:

"So I am eager to preach the gospel to you also who are in Rome. For I am not ashamed of the gospel, for it is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes, to the Jew first and also to the Greek." Romans 1:15-16

The Apostle was eager to proclaim and expound the gospel to *the believers* already gathered in Rome. Why? Because, he reasoned, "it is the power of God for salvation." We often think of salvation as the single moment in time when a sinner repents and puts his faith in Jesus and is instantly forgiven and set free from the penalty (Rom. 8:1) and power of sin (Rom. 8:2-3). But that moment is better understood as *justification* with *salvation* viewed as the entire process from the first tug of Holy Spirit conviction to the final glorification of the believer before the Lord.



And the gospel "is the power of God for salvation to everyone who believes." The message of the good news of Jesus Christ, enlivened by the Holy Spirit, is what enables a non-believer to see their sin and turn from it; it is what opens blind eyes to see a need for Jesus and to take hold of Him by faith; it is what softens a hard heart to receive the Word. But the gospel does not lose its power after repentance and faith unite to provide justification. The gospel goes on to empower the believer for life and godliness, for growth in holiness, for service in ministry and effectiveness in mission.

John Piper has helpfully written that "worship is the fuel and the goal of missions."



I would add that *the gospel is the fuel of worship*. Do you want to energize your love for the Lord? Focus your heart and mind on all that God has done for you in Christ! Reflect on the gospel. Meditate on the ten saving acts of Jesus, which truthfully only scratch the surface of the manifold glory of the gospel. Consider the finished work of Christ. The more we let the gospel fill our hearts and minds the more gratitude and joy we will experience and that will overflow in spiritual growth and ministry for the Lord.

How can you support our team?


- 1. Pray for the team—Pray for preparations for teaching our classes, for hearts to be ready and for us to make the most of the opportunities God provides.

The gospel connects us with the power of God. This is why Paul resolved "to know nothing among you except Jesus Christ and him crucified" (1 Cor. 2:2). This is why he was not ashamed of the gospel. It shows us the justice of God in allowing forgiven sinners into heaven and the righteousness of God to accomplish this salvation for us in Christ. God presented Jesus as a sacrifice of atonement, "to show his righteousness at the present time, so that he might be just and the justifier of the one who has faith in Jesus" (Rom. 3:26).

Not only during this sermon series, but for the rest of your life resolve "to know nothing... except Jesus Christ and him crucified." Center your heart and life on this single glorious truth: "while we were still sinners Christ died for us" (Rom. 5:8). This may sound like a narrow definition of ministry but it is the main thing. In fact, it is the only thing. As Tony Stark said to Pepper when he changed his entire business from weapons manufacturing to develop the Iron Man initiative, "*There is nothing except this*. There's no art opening, no charity, nothing to sign. There's the next mission and nothing else... I finally know what I have to do. And I know in my heart that it's right."

As much as I enjoy the Avengers, I can't give a fictitious character the last word in an article about the gospel. The gospel is the central truth of Christianity and is summed up in the person and work of Jesus. This message not only tells us how to get into a right relationship with God, it gives us the power to take the first step into that relationship and every step through this life and right into eternity. Tim Keller sums it up this way in *King's Cross*:

"Jesus declares not that he has come to reform religion but that he's here to *end* religion and replace it with himself... Religion.. is fundamentally *advice*... The gospel... begins and ends with *news*... Religions are based on the principle that you relate to God by being good... If I perform, if I obey, I'm accepted. The gospel of Jesus is not only different from that but diametrically opposed to it: I'm fully accepted in Jesus Christ, and therefore I obey" (pp. 37 & 39).
