There will be water activities for children so they may want a swimsuit and a towel!








Women's Ministry

Nick & Sofia Audas are our Missionaries of the Month for July. They serve in NYC with Cru, a worldwide missions organization.

We are praising God for this past school year: it truly felt like a breakthrough year for us personally and in ministry at City College of New York. We connect with students in different ways, usually with some type of survey that helps a person share their "life story" and spiritual journey with us. This helps us discover what their experience of faith has been like, what their worldviews, hopes, and dreams are, and find an inroad to be able to share the gospel. In March alone, we saw 26 students come into a relationship with the God who loves them passionately.

Please pray that God would shepherd our student leaders over the summer as they are no longer in school, and that He would prepare a "harvest" of students who would get involved next year.

Last fall, Nick had the wonderful opportunity to minister to a group of ROTC students in NYC. Many of these folks were new Christians so the opportunity to help them get going in their spiritual journey was exciting.

We have adjusted well to New York City and feel it is "home" for us. If you didn't know already, we are adding a "fourth" member of the Audas team this fall.
