## Review

#### God Always Keeps His Word

- God Promised to Punish Sin (2:17)
  - He cursed the serpent
  - He gave consequences to people
- God Promised to Provide a Savior (3:15)
  - To crush the serpent
  - To cover our sin
  - To open the way back into God's presence and blessing
  - To restore the whole world
