Open the Bible!

We have started a one year journey through the whole Bible. "The Bible is one story. It begins in a garden and ends in a city and all the way through it is about Jesus Christ." Pastor Colin Smith of the Orchard Church in Chicago will be our guide on this journey. Please take advantage of the resources his church has provided at www.openthebible.org. You'll find the 50 words that summarize the most prominent themes in Scripture, along with key Scripture passages and teaching for each. Plus you can find five questions every week for discussion in your small group, your home or with a friend.

If you visit www.oakwoodfl.org/open you'll see a personal challenge from Pastor Colin to open the Bible with someone this year. It might be a family member, a friend, a co-worker or neighbor. You could invite them to church to experience the series or just start a conversation about the most published book of all time.

The best way to experience Open will be in a *Community Group*. There are lots of groups meeting at various times and places. Just visit the church website and click Ministries, then Community Groups and you'll find a current list of options. Contact one of the leaders and they will happily give you information on their next group meeting with a warm invitation to visit. As an optional supplement you could read through the whole Bible in 2019. 
Dasis Pregnancy Center

2019 Message Series-*Open*



As Pastor Darin indicated in his article, there are a number of resources available during this series to enhance our journey through the Bible. You can also hear a short audio lesson from Pastor Colin Smith and some additional insights under the "Teaching" tab each week on this site.

Below is a glimpse of our journey through the month of January.

Week 1—Life

God wants you to know that He is the Owner of all things, including you. God also wants you to know that He has made you in His image and that for this reason you have unique dignity and worth.

At the beginning of human history, God made it possible for our first parents to know Him and enjoy Him. He brought the man and his wife together. He led them to their home and gave them their work. He provided all that they needed and shared in their life. What God did for them, He continues to do for all His people. The only difference is that we don't see Him do it. We walk by faith and not by sight (2 Cor. 5:7).

Week 2—Curse

We can only begin to make sense of our world when we understand that we live with the knowledge of evil and are excluded from the presence of God. But God has not abandoned us. He sent His Son into our ongoing battle with evil. Through His death on the cross, He broke the power of the enemy and opened a new and living way into the presence and blessing of God.

Week 3—Salvation

Imagine yourself at a theater for the first performance of a new play. The curtain goes up, but the stage is empty. Then the author walks out and introduces himself to the audience, telling you who he is, why he wrote the play, and what it is about. The author does not present an argument for his own existence, he simply introduces himself and begins to speak about his work.

Week 4—Judgement

God divided mankind into different linguistic groups in order to put a brake on man's growing rebellion. The brake has been remarkably effective. Throughout human history there have been multiple attempts to bring the nations together, but any success has always been limited and short-lived.

But God is bringing people from all nations together through Jesus Christ. In heaven all the barriers that have divided people throughout history—race, class, and language—will be completely removed, and God calls His people to begin expressing that unity now in His church.

Food Bag Ministry

Our PowerHouse students have a monthly fundraiser assembling food bags that are distributed to medical clinics in Tampa, New Port Richey Lakeland, Haines City and Winter Haven and Jacksonville. These bags are distributed to indigent patients at the clinic to provide some basic food needs of the patients and their family.

PowerHouse teens can raise money for summer mission/conference trips by participating in our monthly Food Bag Ministry, typically on the second Sunday of each month. Our next Food Bag prep day is **Sunday**, **January 13** right after the Worship Service.



Teens can raise extra funds by helping shop for the food and/or helping with delivery of the food bags to the medical clinics.
