Review

Outside the ark there was...

- Compromise (6:2) "took any they chose"
- Corruption (6:5) "every intention only evil continually"
- Consequences (6:13) "earth filled w/ violence"
 - \circ "Sin is a growing power *inside* us." Colin Smith
- Condemnation (6:13) "I will destroy them"

Inside the ark there was...

- Protection (6:18) "covenant with you"; (7:7) "to escape"; (7:16) "the Lord shut him in"
- Provision (6:19-21; 7:2-4) "two of every animal"; Blessing (7:7) sons and wives
- Promise (6:9b) "walked with God"; Hope of a Fresh Start (8:16-17)
- Problems The seeds of more sin (9:20-24)
