# **Blood - 2/10 Discussion Questions**

Exodus 12:1-13

### Review

#### Four blessings of the blood of the Lamb

- 1. Identification\_- Jesus' blood marks us as God's children(Exodus 12:12; 6:4-5)
- Non-Jews could become God's children by being marked with the blood (Ex. 12:48)
- $\cdot~$  The blood that identifies also separates those who are God's from those who are not (Ex. 4:22-23)
- 2. Protection Jesus' blood shelters us from God's wrath (Exodus 12:13, 23)

• God's primary purpose in all of history is to prove His absolute supremacy (12:12-13; 7:5; 8:10; 9:14; 10:2)

3. **Purification** – *Jesus' blood cleanses us from the controlling power of sin*(Exodus 3:7-8; 6:6-7)

"For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death." Romans 8:2-3

"If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." 1 John 1:9

4. Satisfaction – Jesus' blood fills us with God's life and power(Exodus 12:3,8,11)

"My flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink... whoever feeds on me, he also will live because of me." John 6:55,57
