Review

"I will also give you rest from all your enemies. The Lord declares to you that **the Lord himself will establish a house for you**." 2 Samuel 7:11

God's Promises make us Confident (v. 11, 27-28)

- 1. **God Promised a Family** (v. 9- 12,14-15)
 - Knowing the price of our Redemption (Eph. 1:5-7) should make us Grateful (v. 18,21-24)
 - o Jesus is the Ultimate Son of David (Matt. 1:1)
- 2. God Promised a Temple (v. 12-13)
 - o To use us as leaders God must first break down our Pride (v. 5-9)
 - Knowing that Everything we have is from God should make us Humble (v. 18,20,22)
 - Jesus is the ultimate Temple (John 2:19-22)
 - o In Christ, We are the Temple of the Spirit (1 Cor. 6:19-20)
- 3. God Promised a Kingdom (v. 16)
 - o God trains His children to Obey (v. 14)
 - o Christ means Anointed King (Mark 1:1)
 - Knowing Jesus reigns over all things should make us Obedient (Matt. 6:33)

- When you reflect on the promises of God does it build up your confidence in Him (i.e. your faith)? Which of these promises is most meaningful to you this week?
