Our Leadership Team

Oakwood is a congregational church that is led by elders. The governing authority for the church is held by our members who entrust oversight of our ministries to a representative group of godly men. Alongside the elders we have a team of deacons (both men and women) who serve the church family by caring for our campus and buildings, financial matters and the physical needs of Oakwood people.

If you are a member of Oakwood, you have the opportunity to participate in our congregational government in April by prayerfully nominating potential elders and deacons. Please visit www.oakwoodfl.org/nominate to find more information on this process and the form to fill out. Forms will also be available at the information center on Sunday mornings. All nominations must be submitted by the end of April!

Elders are godly men (1 Tim. 3:2) who shepherd the people of God (1 Pet. 5:1-2), devoting themselves to "prayer and the ministry of the word" (Acts 6:4). Deacons are godly men and women (1 Tim. 3:8) who manage the practical affairs of the church (Acts 6:1-3). Spiritual leadership is always based on character not gifting. Sometimes exceptional intelligence or ability can get in the way of spiritual power because it is in our weakness that we are actually strongest (2 Cor. 12:9-11). Strength can make us self-reliant, weakness forces us to depend on God.

So the first and primary ongoing role of our elders (of which our pastor is one) is prayer. We regularly gather to cry out to the Lord even as we individually intercede for the needs of the church family. (Yes, we read and pray for what you write on those connection cards every week!) The next job of our elders is shepherding. We are called to minister to the spiritual needs of the church family. So most of our elders serve as small group leaders, the primary way we care for and disciple our people. The third task of elders is leadership. We prayerfully discern God's will for Oakwood in terms of both long range planning and short term priorities.

Deacons focus on the physical needs of the church – both our people and property. You may not always see them working, but you certainly see the results of their work in our well maintained buildings and grounds. And you see the fruit of their labors in our weekly reporting of church giving against budget and expenses. Our deacons ensure that we are excellent stewards of every dollar you invest in Oakwood. Finally, the deacons respond to physical needs in the church family by administering our compassion fund. We collect contributions for this once a month and our deacons distribute those funds as requests come in.

Below is a glimpse of our journey through the month of March.

Week 14

Prophet—If you have ever wished that God would speak to you, you need to know that He does. God speaks through His Word and by His Spirit. When His Word is opened, His voice is heard.

As you study the Bible and hear it proclaimed, you will find that God says some things that can be hard to take. Hearing the truth about your sins will make you uncomfortable. But whenever God speaks, it is a sign of His grace. His purpose is always to restore and to bless.

Week 15

Temple—The cloud of God's presence in the temple pointed forward to what God would do in Christ. God took human flesh and came down among us in Jesus Christ. When we believe in Him, God's presence enters our lives by the Holy Spirit, giving us a foretaste of the joys that lie ahead when we will live with Him forever.

Week 16

Worship—Authentic worship is always a response to revealed truth. It is directed toward the living God, focused around the Lord Jesus Christ, and inspired by the Holy Spirit. True worship will be fostered where God's truth is proclaimed, where Jesus Christ is exalted, and where God's people submit to the work of the Holy Spirit in their lives.

If you want to grow in your worship, open your Bible and soak your mind in what God says about Himself. The Holy Spirit will use the truth to stimulate worship in your heart.

Student Summer Trip

Our Middle and High School students will head to New Orleans this July for a Missions Ministry trip with NOLA:Fusion, sponsored by Urban Impact Ministries. Below is information on what they will be doing during their week of ministry:

NOLA:Fusion Defined: merging of diverse, distinct, or separate elements into a unified whole

Fusion is our mission ministry that hosts teams every June and July.

One of the largest aspects of **NOLA:Fusion** is the Relational Ministry students will do in our neighborhood. After training, it's hands on time. Through service at Day Camp, Recreation Outreach and Challenge Circle, we concentrate on teaching you how to communicate your faith. You are given opportunity after opportunity to share your faith as we minister alongside local missionaries, pastors, church member, and indigenous leaders.

Food Bag Ministry

Our PowerHouse students have a monthly fundraiser assembling food bags that are distributed to medical clinics in Tampa, New Port Richey Lakeland, Haines City and Winter Haven and Jacksonville. These bags are distributed to indigent patients at the clinic to provide some basic food needs of the patients and their family.

PowerHouse teens can raise money for summer mission/conference trips by participating in our monthly Food Bag Ministry, typically on the second Sunday of each month. Our next Food Bag prep day is **Sunday**, **April 14** right after the Worship Service.



Teens can raise extra funds by helping shop for the food and/or helping with delivery of the food bags to the medical clinics.
