 - You just know you're saved (Rom. 8:16)
 - You just can't keep sinning (1 John 3:6)
- 4. Eternal (v. 37)
 - "I will never leave you or forsake you." (Heb. 13:5)
- 5. Redemption (v. 34b)

- The basis for the blessings of the new covenant is found in the last line of v. 34 after the word "for." How does this predict the redemptive sacrifice of Jesus that we celebrate in the Lord's Supper?
