## **Preview**

# How to call one another **Up**:

- 1. Spend **Time** together (v. 1, 3-6)
- 2. Speak <u>Truth</u> to one another (v. 1, 7)
  - a. parakaleo "to call alongside"
  - b. Affirmation and **Exhortation**
- 3. Share in **Trials** with the hurting (v. 9-12)

- 12. What is one way you can apply the heart of this passage to your life?
- 13. What will you do differently because of what you learned?
- 14. Who is one person you could share this truth with?

- 1. As a result of this passage, how can we pray for God to change you?
- 2. How can we pray for God to move in your relationships (marriage, family, friends, coworkers)?
- 3. How can we pray for God to move in other situations?
