

August 1 Discussion Questions "Solid Ground"

Acts 28:1-11

Preview

Don't use Circumstances to determine:

- Your <u>Value</u> "I matter because..." (v. 2-4)
- Your <u>Happiness</u> "I'm happy because..." (v. 7-10)
- God's **Faithfulness** "I believe God is good because..." (27:27)

Instead, establish your value and happiness on the faithfulness of God

- "I matter because..."
 - God <u>made</u> me (Ps. 139:13)
 - God <u>loves</u> me (1 Jn. 4:10a)
 - Jesus <u>died</u> for me (1 Jn. 4:10b)
 - God has a **plan** for my life (Eph. 2:10)

• "I'm happy because ... "

- God is <u>with</u> me (Heb. 13:5)
- God is **enough** for me (Ps. 37:4)
- Jesus conquered sin and <u>death</u> (1 Cor. 15:57)
- Jesus is **coming** soon to fix everything (1 Thes. 4:16-17)

OPENING QUESTIONS

1. Are you afraid of snakes? What other things are you afraid of? Why do you think that is?

PRAY - Pray for God's blessing on your conversation - to illuminate your minds, transform your hearts, and draw you closer together as a group.

READ THE PASSAGE — Acts 28:1-11

DISCUSSION & APPLICATION

- 2. What happened to Paul while on the island of Malta? How did the natives respond? How did this change after Paul went unaffected?
- 3. Why do you think Paul's life and ministry was so full of hardship?
- 4. Why does hardship make us question our value? Has there been a time in your life that you questioned your significance to God? What did God teach you?
- 5. Why might Paul have left the island of Malta disappointed in his ministry effectiveness there? (i.e. Did he establish any churches or raise up elders?)
- 6. What is disappointing or challenging in your life right now? How has it affected your daily happiness?
- 7. What things are you inclined to turn to for happiness when you lack happiness in God?
- 8. What character attributes or promises of God do you need to cling to and preach to yourself right now?
- 9. What does it look like to have happiness in God in the midst of real loss?
- 10. What ministry opportunity did Paul find while on the island of Malta?
- 11. What ministry opportunities has God put in your life right now? Are you finding the strength and discipline to faithfully fulfill this opportunity?
- 12. Read Colossian 1:28-29. What does it mean to operate in God's strength? How do you increase your reception and reliance on God's strength for ministry?
- 13. What is your key takeaway from this text or from your discussion? How is God working in your heart?

PRAYER

- <u>Personal Request</u>: Pray we would establish our value and happiness on the faithfulness of God, not our circumstances.
- <u>Ministry Request</u>: Pray for the Men's Ministry Team as they implement opportunities for the men of Oakwood to build relationships and grow in their faith.
