Discipleship Group Session #3 SERVE THE CHURCH

3. What is a way you have served others that personally brought you great joy?


READ: John 13:34-35

DISCUSS

- 8. What has influenced how you define a "loving relationship?" Family? Friends? Media? God's Word? Why is it important that only God's Word tell us what loving relationships look like?
- 9. Share the various ways Jesus has demonstrated love for us and what that means for the way we are to love one another.
- 10. How is it that our witness for Christ among unbelievers is influenced by our love for other Christians? Can you give a specific example of a time when your love or lack of love influenced an unbeliever?
- 11. In what ways has your love for the church grown or been challenged over the years?
- 12. Why is it important that we serve the church?
